## Christmas in a Backpack '09'

The backpack team traveled to the most remote area

**of India we have ever experienced over these past 9 years** that we have been working in India. The villages in the State of Bihar are not even comparable to anything you can imagine here in the USA. Our worst poverty doesn't even scratch the surface. These precious people live without electricity in mud huts. They literally live and survive off the land. It was almost more than we could comprehend. This time of year in Bihar is extremely cold.....very heart breaking to see these children with no shoes or proper clothing for the conditions. Not only are they extremely physically poor, but most importantly spiritually lost. Less than one percent of them have heard about Christ. As Matt Wethington, senior pastor of Riverbend Baptist Church, shared with the children and adults at the backpack programs, they hung on every word he said through the interpreter. The tents could only hold 500 plus, so hundreds stood in the dirt streets to listen over the speakers.... there were even teenagers in the trees so they could see in. It was incredible!



Over 850 children and adults prayed to receive Christ!! To God be the Glory! Even though the local police visited us and satan had plans to prevent the program, God had other plans. He can truly silence our enemies; we saw that first hand! I don't think this team will ever forget the awesome power of prayer we felt. Thank you so much for praying for us!

**We were able to distribute 1000 backpacks (500 in each village). The backpacks were full of gifts. They received a wool blanket, bath towel, flip flops, shirt, soap, hair oil, comb, mirror, underwear, small toy,**
